Herding Specifications

The trials are open to aussies and all ASCA approved herding breeds.

Ducks: mixed Khaki

Sheep: mix Barbados Black Belly/ Drents heideschaap

Cattle : Holstein

Entry's are taken by postmark.

Entry's will be taken starting March 1 2012.

Entry's end April 15.

The trials will consist of:

14 duck runs

21 sheep runs

15 cattle runs

Handler is responsible for his dog and must keep dog under control at all times. Handler is responsible for damage done to the livestock.

Replacement fee ducks; euro 20,00

Replacement fee sheep ; euro 250, 00

Replacement fee Cattle; Market value

Handler will be responsible for any injury caused by their actions or that of their dog. Bitches in season will run last. Runs will be determined randomly prior to trial.

Stock dog awards

Ribbons awarded for 1st through 4th place.

Qualifying ribbons for qualifying scores.

Ribbons for High in Trial and High Combined per trial, per day.

High combined award will be the scores of 3 livestock combined both Q and Non Q. there have to be at least 2 combinations in order to win this prize

A dog running the new courses will get his points +15% to calculate the High Combined.

Directions to trial site:

From Arnhem (A12) take A 50 to Zwolle. Then A 28 towards Groningen/Meppel. Then A 32 towards Meppel/Leeuwarden. Exit Wolvega N 351 towards Oosterwolde. First roundabout take left (N 353) to Oldeberkoop. Next roundabout take a right towards Gorredijk. (N 380) At the curve keep going straight towards Jubbega. After 5 km. You come to Hoornsterzwaag. JJ RANCH is nr. 42 on your right.

Course 1 ducks:

Handler note : Emphasis will be placed on calm, efficient, gentle stock handling

Open class: Handler may assist dog with any tasks as needed

Advanced class: The majority of each task should be completed with minimal handler assistance

5 ducks are set in the take pen. Time starts when opening the takepen.

Pen work 1, 15 points

Take the 5 ducks out of take pen, and settle stock against back fence.

Sorting work 25 points:

Sort 3 marked ducks into sorting pen "A "

Leave 2 remaining head in the arena

After sorting is done,

let the dog stay in the arena and take the ducks out of the pen into the arena

Gather work 25 points:

Settle ducks near take pen. Take dog with you to pole.

Advanced handlers : Let the dog hold the stock against the back fence. Then walk to pole. When at the pole call your dog to you, then proceed the course

Pole is set at 75 feet.

Open handlers may go ½ way between dog and stock (will be marked with a cone)
Advanced handlers remain at the pole.

Fetch ducks and settle near the top fence. (marked with cones)

Advanced handlers must settle stock in between the cones.

Specific task 1, 15 points

Take ducks trough the footbath. (D) Footbath entrance 7 feet, footbath exit 2 feet
(footbath is 2 x 4 feet)

Chute work 25 points:

Take ducks trough exit gate 1. Close gate 1 behind you.

Open handlers: Let dog bring the stock into the squeeze. (2) Stop the ducks at the squeeze gate.

Advanced Handlers: Let the dog drive the stock into the squeeze and hold them. Handler remains at the gate. Then walk over to release the ducks.

Specific task 2 : 15 points:

Release ducks from squeeze. (close squeeze gate again)

Return trough gate 1 into arena. (close gate 1)

Pen work 2 , 10 points:

Re pen ducks in take pen, open gate to sorting pens, put ducks back in sorting pens. (C)

Time ends when gate to sortingpens is closed.

Time for ducks 15 minutes

3 minute warning time at 12 minutes.

Ties are broken by time.

Pole is set at 75 feet.

Open handlers may go ½ way between dog and stock (will be marked with a cone)

Advanced handlers remain at the pole.

Fetch ducks and settle near the top fence. (marked with cones)

Advanced handlers must settle stock between the cones.

Specific task 1, 15 points

Take ducks trough the footbath (D) Footbath entrance 7 feet, footbath exit 2 feet
(footbath is 2 x 4 feet)

Sorting work 25 points:

Sort 3 marked ducks into sorting pen "A "

Leave 2 remaining head in the arena

After sorting is done,

Let the dog stay in the arena and take the ducks out of the pen into the arena

Chute work 25 points:

Take ducks trough exit gate 1 , Close gate 1 behind you

Let dog bring the stock into the squeeze. (2) Stop the ducks at the squeeze gate.

Advanced Handlers: Let the dog drive the stock into the squeeze and hold them. Handler remains at the gate. Then walk over to release the ducks.

Ducks course 3

5 ducks are set in takepen

Penwork 15 points:

Take ducks out of takepen and release into the arena.

Chute work 25 points:

Take ducks through exit gate 1 , Close gate 1 behind you

Let dog bring the stock into the squeeze. (2) Stop the ducks at the squeeze gate.

Advanced Handlers: Let the dog drive the stock into the squeeze and hold them. Handler remains at the gate. Then walk over to release the ducks.

Specific task 2 : 15 points:

Release ducks from squeeze. (close squeeze gate again)

Return trough gate 1 into arena. (close gate 1)

Sorting work 25 points:

Sort 3 marked ducks into sorting pen "A "

Leave 2 remaining head in the arena

After sorting is done,

let the dog stay in the arena and take the ducks out of the pen into the arena

Settle stock near the takepengate

Gather work 25 points:

Open handlers: Take dog with you to pole.

Advanced handlers : Let the dog hold the stock against the backfence. Then walk to pole. When at the pole call your dog to you, then proceed the course

Pole is set at 75 feet.

Open handlers may go ½ way between dog and stock (will be marked with a cone)

Advanced handlers remain at the pole.

Fetch ducks and settle near the top fence. (marked with cones)

Advanced handlers must settle stock between the cones, dog must hold the stock while handler walks to the narrow end of the chute

Specific task 1, 15 points

Take ducks through the footbath (D) Footbath entrance 7 feet, footbath exit 2 feet
(footbath is 2 x 4 feet)

Pen work 2 , 10 points:

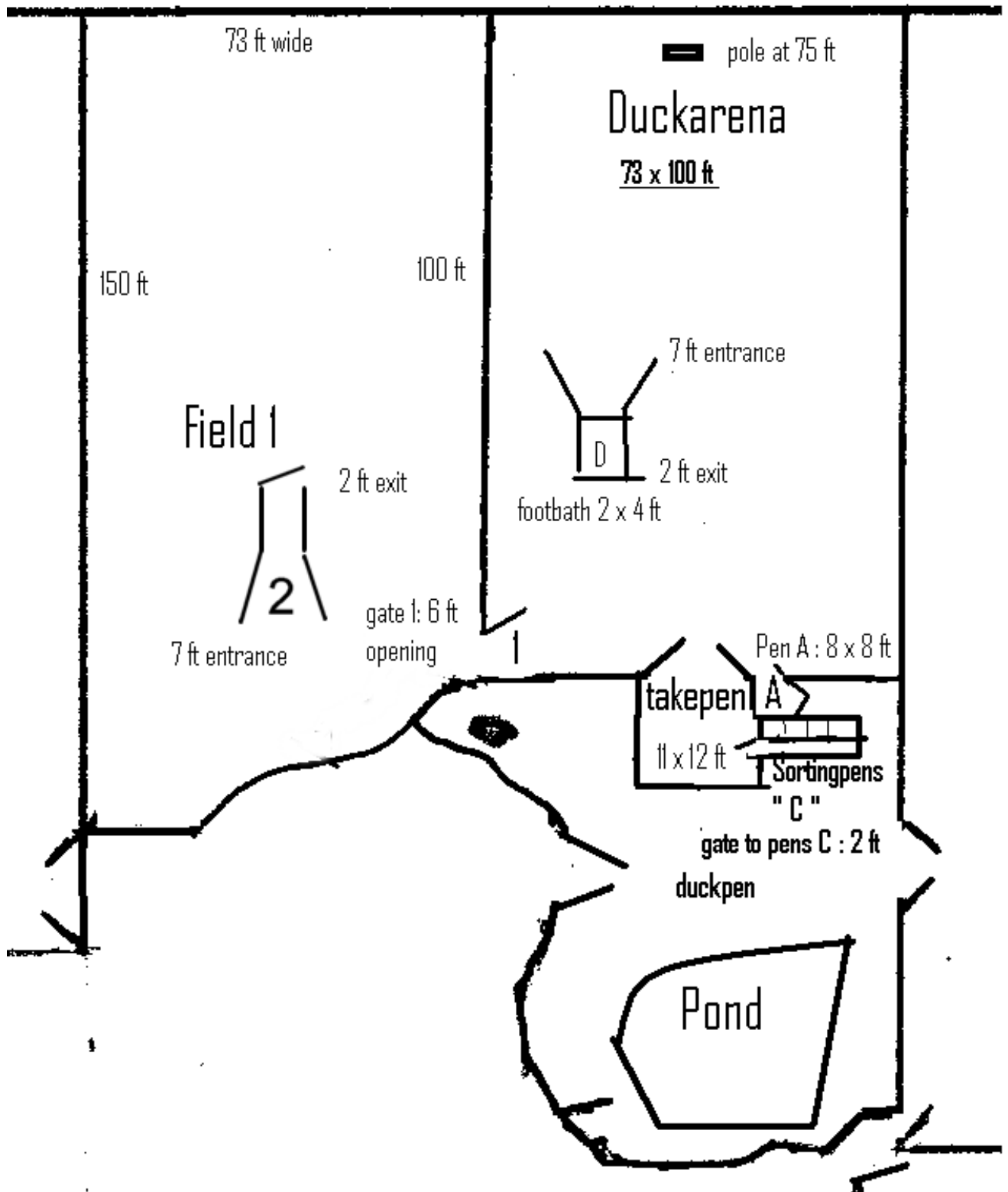
Re pen ducks in take pen, open gate to sorting pens, put ducks back in sorting pens. (C)

Time ends when gate to sorting pens is closed

Time for ducks : 15 minutes

3 minute warning time at 12 minutes.

Ties are broken by time.



Cattle/sheep course 1

Handler note: Emphasis will be placed on calm, efficient, gentle stock handling.

Open class : Handler may assist the dog with any tasks as needed

Advanced class : The majority of each task should be completed with minimal handler assistance

Sort work 25 points:

Time starts when opening the sorting gate.

5 head of stock is set in the square pen "A"

Open the gate to holdingpen 1

Advanced handlers holdingpen2

Sort 3 marked animals.

When sort is complete, take the dog into the arena

Pen work 25 points:

Bring the 3 sorted head back to the squarepen to join the remaining 2, while the dog stays in the arena. When group is complete, call you dog back and take the group out of squarepen "A " and release into arena. Leave stock settled at the back fence.

Advanced handlers must stay at the takepen gate, while dog brings the stock out of squarepen.

Dog will hold the stock, while handler goes back to close the gate to the squarepen.

Gather work 25 points:

Open handlers : Take dog with you to the top of the arena. Pole is set at 150 feet.

Open : Handler may move ½ way between dog and stock (marked with a cone)

Advanced handlers : Let the dog hold the stock against the back fence. Then walk to pole. When at the pole call your dog to you, then proceed the course

Advanced : Handler remains at the pole.

Settle stock to the top fence of the arena. (marked area)

Advanced handlers must settle stock between the cones. When stock is settled, let the dog hold the stock, till the handler arrives at the narrow end of the chute.

Specific task 1: 15 points:

Take stock trough chute and footbath "D "

Specific task 2 : 15 points

Take stock trough gates "E "and "F ", close gate's behind you.

Take stock around the pond, to gate "G "

Advanced handlers : gates to field 1 will be open

Chute work 25 points:

Bring stock trough squeeze chute "B "

Stop the stock at the squeeze gate.

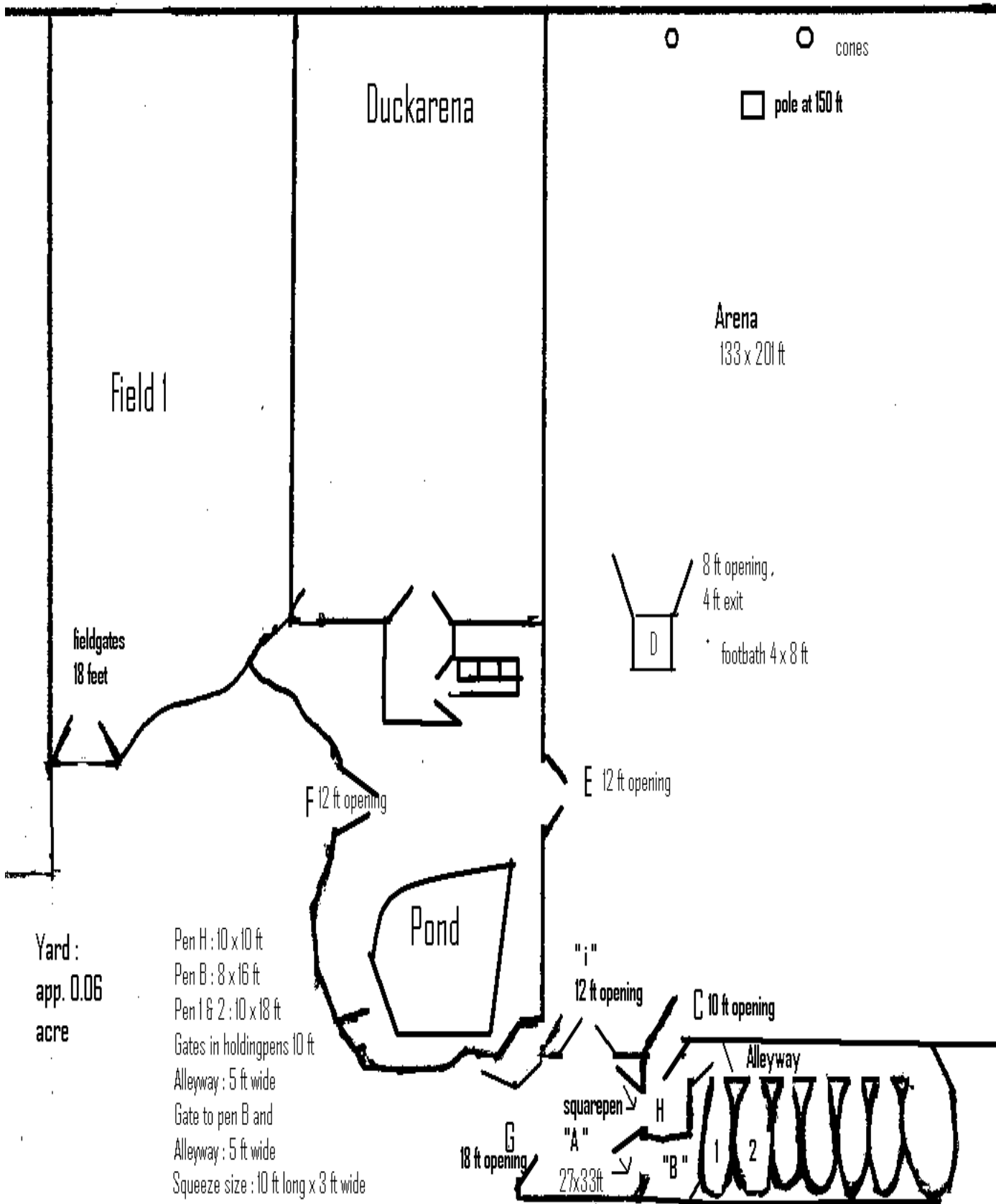
Then release stock into pen 1

Advanced handlers : release 2 head of stock, close gate, then release the others in pen 2

Time ends when all gates are closed.

Time for sheep : 15 minutes, 3 minute warning time at 12 minutes. Ties are broken by time

Time for cattle : 19 minutes, 3 minute warning time at 16 minutes. Ties are broken by time



Cattle/ sheep course 2

Pen work 1, 10 points

Time starts when opening gate " i "

Take 5 head of stock out of squarepen " A " and release in the arena (trough gates " i ")

Settle them against backfence.

Gatherwork 25 points:

Open handlers: Take dog with you to the top of the arena. Pole is set at 150 feet.

Advanced handlers : Let the dog hold the stock against the backfence. Then walk to pole. When at the pole call your dog to you, then proceed the course

Advanced : Handler remains at the pole.

Open : Handler may move ½ way between dog and stock (marked with a cone)

Settle stock to the topfence of the arena. (marked area)

Advanced handlers must settle stock between the cones. When stock is settled, let the dog hold the stock, till the handler arrives at the narrow end of the chute.

Specific task 1 : 15 points:

Take stock trough chute and footbath "D "

And return stock trough gates " i "into squarepen.

Sortwork 25 points:

Open the gate to holdingpen 1, advanced handlers holdingpen 2

Sort 3 marked animals.

Penwork 15 points:

When sort is complete, bring the dog to the arena, then bring the 3 sorted animals back to square pen "A " to join the remaining 2. Walk around to gates "I " and take stock from square pen

Specific task 2 : 15 points

Take stock trough gates "E "and "F ", close gate's behind you.

Take stock around the pond to gate "G "

Advanced handlers: gates to field 1 will be open.

Chutework 25 points:

Bring stock trough squeeze chute "B "

Stop the stock at the squeeze gate.

Then release stock into pen 1

Advanced handlers : release 2 head of stock, close gate, then release the others in pen 2

Time ends when all gates are closed.

Time for sheep : 15 minutes, 3 minute warning time at 12 minutes. Ties are broken by time
Time for cattle : 19 minutes, 3 minute warning time at 16 minutes. Ties are broken by time

Cattle/ sheep course 3

5 head of stock is set in squarepen "A "
Time starts when opening gates "G "

Penwork 15 points

Take stock out of squarepen and close gate behind you.

Specific task 1, 15 points

Bring stock around the pond to gate "E "and "F "
Close gates behind you.

Advanced handlers : gates to field 1 will be open

Let stock settle against the fence near the takepen

Gatherwork 25 points:

Open handlers: Take dog with you to the top of the arena. Pole is set at 150 feet.

Advanced handlers : Let the dog hold the stock against the backfence. Then walk to pole. When at the pole call your dog to you, then proceed the course

Advanced : Handler remains at the pole.

Open : Handler may move ½ way between dog and stock (marked with a cone)

Settle stock to the topfence of the arena. (marked area)

Advanced handlers must settle stock between the cones. When stock is settled, let the dog hold the stock, till the handler arrives at the narrow end of the chute.

Specific task 2: 15 points:

Take stock trough chute and footbath "D "

Sortwork 25 points

sort 3 marked animals into holdingpen " H "

When sort is complete, leave dog in arena while taking the 3 sorted head out of the takepen

Penwork 10 points

Bring stock into squarepen trough gate "i "

Chutework 25 points:

Bring stock trough squeeze chute "B "

Stop the stock at the squeeze gate.

Then release stock into pen 1

Time ends when all gates are closed.

Time for sheep : 15 minutes, 3 minute warning time at 12 minutes. Ties are broken by time
Time for cattle : 19 minutes, 3 minute warning time at 16 minutes. Ties are broken by time
